

ISTRIA: BASED IN ONE HOTEL

DIFFICULTY: easy

DURATION: 8 days / 7 nights

DISTANCE: approx. 270 km

DESCRIPTION

The base of your bicycle holiday will be Poreč, which is probably the most important coast town at the west coast of the peninsula Istria in Croatia. Probably the most famous building in Poreč is the Episcopal building with the Euphrasius Basilica, which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE ROUTE

Most of the time the route runs along traffic free side roads in the hinterland of Istria or along the coast. The tour is suitable for children over 14 years.



A DAY BY DAY ACCOUNT OF THE ROUTE

Day 1: Arrival

Individual arrival at the hotel in Poreč. We suggest a visit to the Euphrasian Basilica - listed as UNESCO World Heritage.

Day 2: Round trip Poreč (approx. 35 km)

The first cycling day takes you on an exploration tour through the hinterland of Poreč. First you cycle along the coast to the bathing resort Santa Marina di Vabriga and then to Vabriga. You leave the coast again and continue cycling in the inland to Višnjan and back to Poreč.

Day 3: Poreč – Vrsar – Limski channel – Poreč (approx. 40 km)

Today you will cycle from Poreč to the famous fjord-like Limski channel with its blue shimmering water. Today the Limski channel is a National Park and on the coast you find mussels and oyster farms. Through the inland you will get back to Poreč.

Day 4: Grožnjan – Buje – Novigrad – Poreč (approx. 55 km)

After a short transfer you will reach the artists' village of Grožnjan. It is today a meeting point for musicians from all over the world. During summer a lot of classical concerts with young musicians take place here. In the second half of July you can join the festival "Jazz is back". In the end of September artists meet for "Ex Tempore" – performing arts. From Grožnjan you cycle passing Buje downhill to the Adriatic coast and along to Novigrad (in Italian *Cittanova*). This small medieval town is surrounded by a defensive wall and is seated at the mouth of the Mirna river. On your way back you will pass the cave "Jama Baredine" – a dripstone cave, before reaching Poreč again.

Day 5: Motovun – Poreč (approx. 45 km)

After a short transfer to the hinterland of Poreč the first stop is Motovun, a formerly important strategic point of the Venetians, invulnerable on the top of a steep hill. You may surround this medieval town and enjoy the breath taking view on the surrounded hilly landscape, the sea and the Mirna valley. Along the Parenzana cycle path you continue your ride to Vižinada from where you will see once again the impressing town of Motovun before going back to Poreč.

Day 6: Poreč - Rovinj (approx. 55 km)

Today you will reach Rovinj, one of the most beautiful cities in Istria. Rovinj is surrounded in the west and the south west by the Adriatic Sea. Afar the high bell tower of the Euphemia Church built on the highest spot of Rovinj, greats you. Go ahead, if you would like to cycle to Zlatni rt (also known as Golden Cape), a peninsula, where you find a park in a nature reserve. Return transfer to Poreč in the afternoon.

Day 7: Kanfanar – Pula (approx. 40 km)

After a transfer to Kanfanar you cycle through wide woods to Pula. In Fažana you have the possibility to visit the Brijuni islands by boat. Continue your cycling trip to Pula, the biggest city of Istria. Famous for the antique places of interest like the amphitheatre. Return transfer to Poreč in the evening.

Day 8: Departure

Individual departure or possibility to extend your stay.

ARRIVAL

By car: Via the Tauern motorway to Villach and over the border crossing Arnoldstein to Udine and Trieste. From Trieste on the motorway to Koper (toll charge!) and via the E751 through Slovenia to Croatia – Poreč (toll charge!).

By plane: Airports Ronchi dei Legionari (Trieste) or Pula. There are good bus connections (airport shuttle) from the airport Ronchi dei Legionari to Trieste. From there you continue by bus.

Hotel in 4-star-category // Attention: Tourist tax – if requested – has to be paid on the spot.

Car parking available at your starting-hotel. Reservation of the parking area not possible; payable on the spot.
